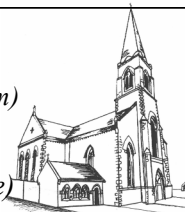

A Prayer to the Creator

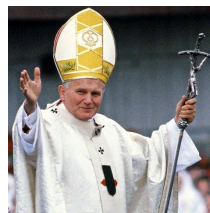
Lord, Father of our human family,
