First Holy Communion & Confirmation: Due to Bishop Alan's guidance in light of the Taoiseach's announcement, our First Holy Communion Mass which was due to take place on May 15th has now been postponed. The Confirmation Mass which was due to take place on May 29th has also been postponed.

### Reminder for everyone aged 60 and over to register for their vaccine

We would like to remind everyone aged 65-69 to register for their COVID-19 vaccine through the HSE's online registration system or on the phone with HSELive. If someone is finding it difficult to go online and register or they can ring HSELive for support on 1850 24 1850 or 01 240 8787 from 8am to 8pm, 7 days. If a person doesn't have a PPSN they can register on the phone with HSElive. Once registered the person will receive their vaccine appointment for the COVID-19 AstraZeneca vaccine. If a person is deaf or hard of hearing, they can text HSELive on 086 1800 661 to register for your vaccination.
