



### **Resumption of Public Mass**

The dispensation from attending Mass is still in place because of the pandemic. All our Masses, weekday and weekend, are streamed on the internet and are best accessed from the parish website. Public Mass has resumed for restricted numbers (50 maximum) in both Sts Alphonsus & Columba and the Church of the Apostles. If you have an underlying condition or are unwell, especially with respiratory symptoms or a temperature, please do not to come to public Mass, but continue to participate online or via TV. We would ask you please to queue up outside the church (keeping the 2 meters distance) and to follow the instructions of our stewards on hand sanitising, where to sit, and Holy Communion. Please follow the one-way system in the church. And facial coverings are strongly recommended.

**Funeral Masses** are still limited to 50 family members and close friends and the 2 meters distance needs to be respected in the church and church grounds.

**The Sacrament of Confirmation** for small groups will take place in September and October.

Bookings for Confirmation are now closed and, because the numbers for indoor gatherings are staying at 50, only 4 people per family may attend the ceremony: the child, the sponsor, and the 2 parents or guardians. An online preparation video from the Irish bishops will be available shortly.
