FEAST DAYS THIS WEEK

21 Nov – **Presentation of the Blessed Virgin Mary**. This feast highlights the holiness of Mary from the beginning of her life on earth that continued through her early childhood and beyond.

22 Nov - **St Cecilia** (3rd century) virgin and martyr, patron of music. Though a late fourth century church in Rome was named after her, nothing is known of her life or death. She was buried in the catacomb of San Callisto. Popular legends were written about her in the late fifth century, and in the sixteenth century she was named the patron of music. Honoured by the Church as a virgin, martyred for the faith, her name is included in Eucharistic Prayer I.

23 Nov - **St Columban** 543-615 abbot and missionary, was born in Leinster and died in 615 at Bobbio (Italy). A monk and teacher at Bangor until middle aged who left with twelve companions as "exiles for Christ" to found monasteries in Burgundy (France). Author of a monastic rule and a penitential. Noted for his austerity of life, his missionary energy, and his role in the development of individual reconciliation. Robert Schumann, a Prime Minister of France, who was credited with being the founding father of the EEC said: "St. Columban, this illustrious Irishman who left his own country for voluntary exile, willed and achieved a spiritual union between the principal European countries of his time. He is the patron saint of all those who now seek to build a United Europe".

24 Nov - **Saints Andrew Dung-Lac and Companions** were beheaded at Hanoi and are listed among 117 canonised martyrs who died in Vietnam between 1820 and 1862: ninety six Vietnamese, eleven Spanish Dominicans, and ten presbyters from the Paris Foreign Mission Society. They represent the thousands of Christians tortured and martyred in Vietnam between the 17th and 19th centuries: clergy and lay people, children and adults.

24 Nov - **St Colman of Cloyne** (522-604) patron of Cloyne diocese

25 Nov - **St Catherine of Alexandria** (282-305) virgin and martyr

26 Nov - **St Leonard of Porto Maurizio** (1676-1751) was a Franciscan priest and retreat preacher. To keep alive the religious fervour awakened during his many missions, Leonard promoted the Stations of the Cross as a reminder of the cost of God's forgiveness.

27 Nov - **St Feargal of Salzburg** (700-784) monk, missionary, bishop was born in Ireland. He lived in France and in Bavaria, where he founded the monastery of Chiemsee.
